UNITED STATES ALLIES, CIA RECRUITS, ARE BEING TORTURED STARVED AND KILLED!

October 22, 2006

To: Elected Officials, Media Representatives, Ladies and Gentlemen:

We the Lao Human Rights Council and local Hmong American organizations have appealed to the United States Government and the United Nations Security Council to take immediate action to stop the Lao Peoples Democratic Republic from continuing to commit genocide against the Lao Hmong in hiding in the jungles of Laos.

For more than 30 years the Lao Hmong have endured genocide by the LPDR. The Lao military is currently engaging in aggressive military operations, air raids, ground troop actions, chemical attacks and mass starvation tactics indented to wipe out the Lao Hmong in hiding in several restricted zones in Laos. The atrocities and human rights violations are known and witnessed by many independent eye witnesses and have been brought to the attention of high level officials of the United Nations and the United States Government.

The Lao Hmong have been in hiding for nearly 30 years in the jungles of Laos and are constantly being hunted by the LPDR who have joined forces with Vietnamese military units. Mass starvation is being used against our trapped people to eliminate them from Laos. The living conditions are unbearable and demand immediate help. A lengthy non-government report has been completed and submitted to the United Nations iin the hope it will be used effectively in addressing the ongoing genocide of our people. Copies of this important report are available through the Lao Human Rights Council, Inc. U.S.A.

The thousands of Hmong refugees have no choice but to seek refuge in Thailand because of the ongoing genocide in Laos. The influx of refugees is mounting. The Lao Hmong crisis must be addressed immediately.

The United Nations and the United States Government have already been fostering a productive dialogue to prevent genocide and ethnic cleansing and human rights violations and have achieved tremendous success. WE now propose that the United Nations and the United States Government extend this initiative to include the Lao Hmong crisis.
